Exit trim push button retrofit kit



Overview

The Schlage AD-993 internal push button retrofit kit relocates the push button from the interior escutcheon of the lock to the exit device to meet the specific needs of California Building Code accessibility standards, Section 11B-404.2.7.

The push button retains the same functionality as when it is located on the AD-933 interior trim but is located below the required height of 44" from the finished floor. The LED indication light will remain active on the AD-993 interior trim.

This retrofit kit is available for the AD-993 with Von Duprin 98/99 exit devices with the follow options:

- Rim, concealed vertical rod (CVR) / concealed vertical cable (CVC), XP, mortise, and surface vertical rod (SVR) devices
- Right hand reverse or left hand reverse door handing
- 7 popular finishes: Satin Chrome (626), Bright Brass (605), Satin Brass (606), Satin Nickel (619), Bright Chrome (625), Aged Bronze (643e) and Satin Chrome with an antimicrobial coating (626AM)

The kit includes all parts needed to retrofit an existing installation

- Push button components
- Replacement AD Series interior cover
- Replacement Von Duprin 98/99 center case
- Replacement Von Duprin 98/99 center case cover
- Instructions
